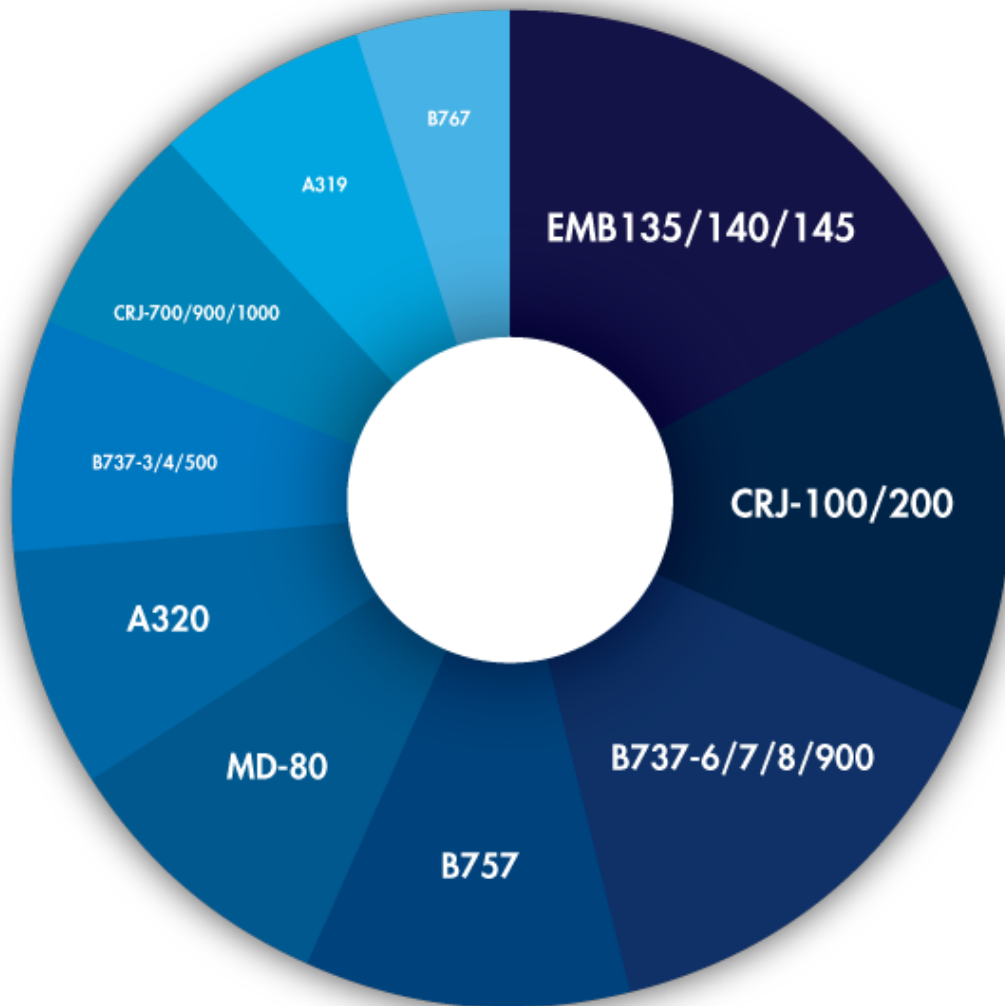

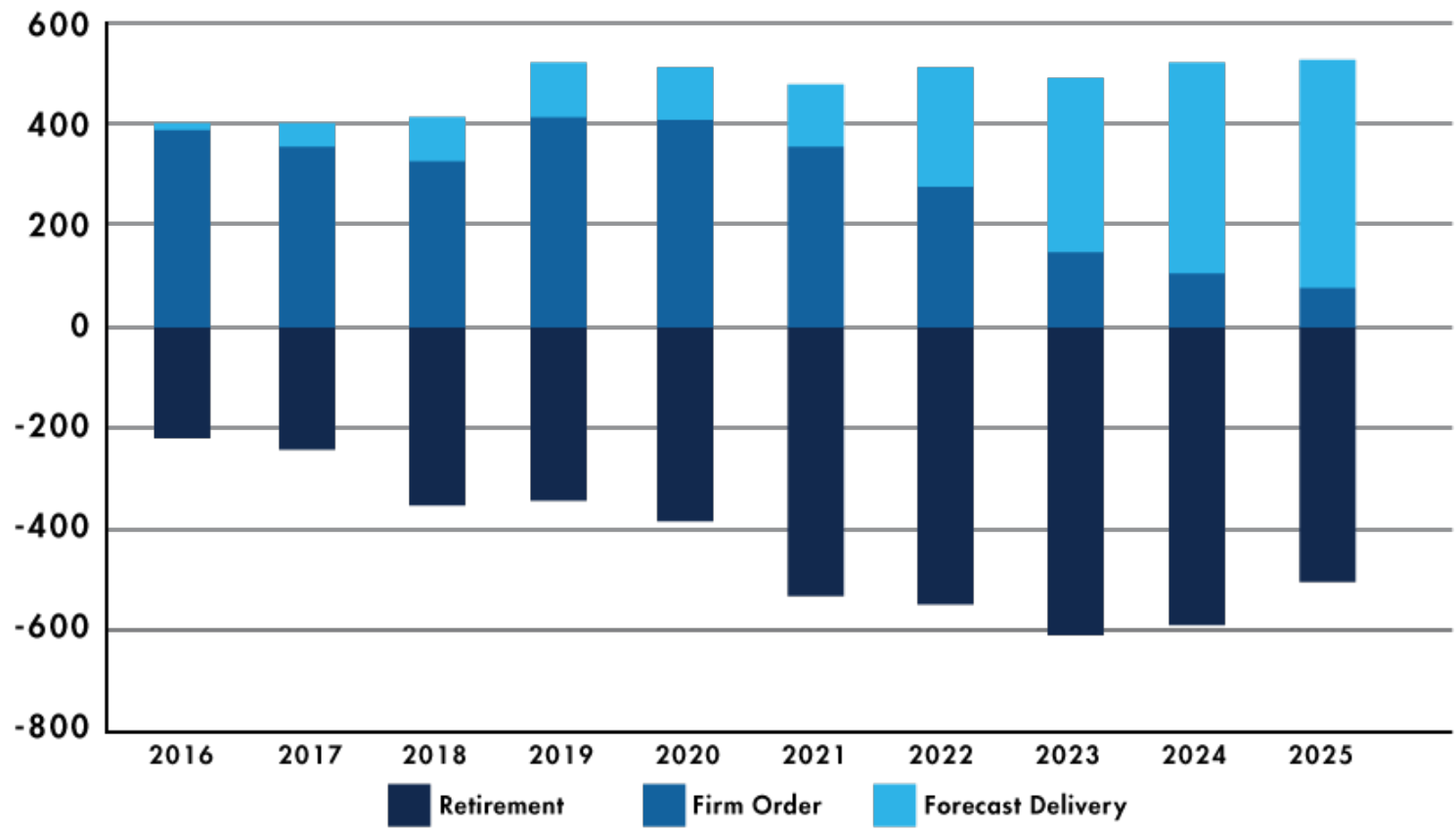

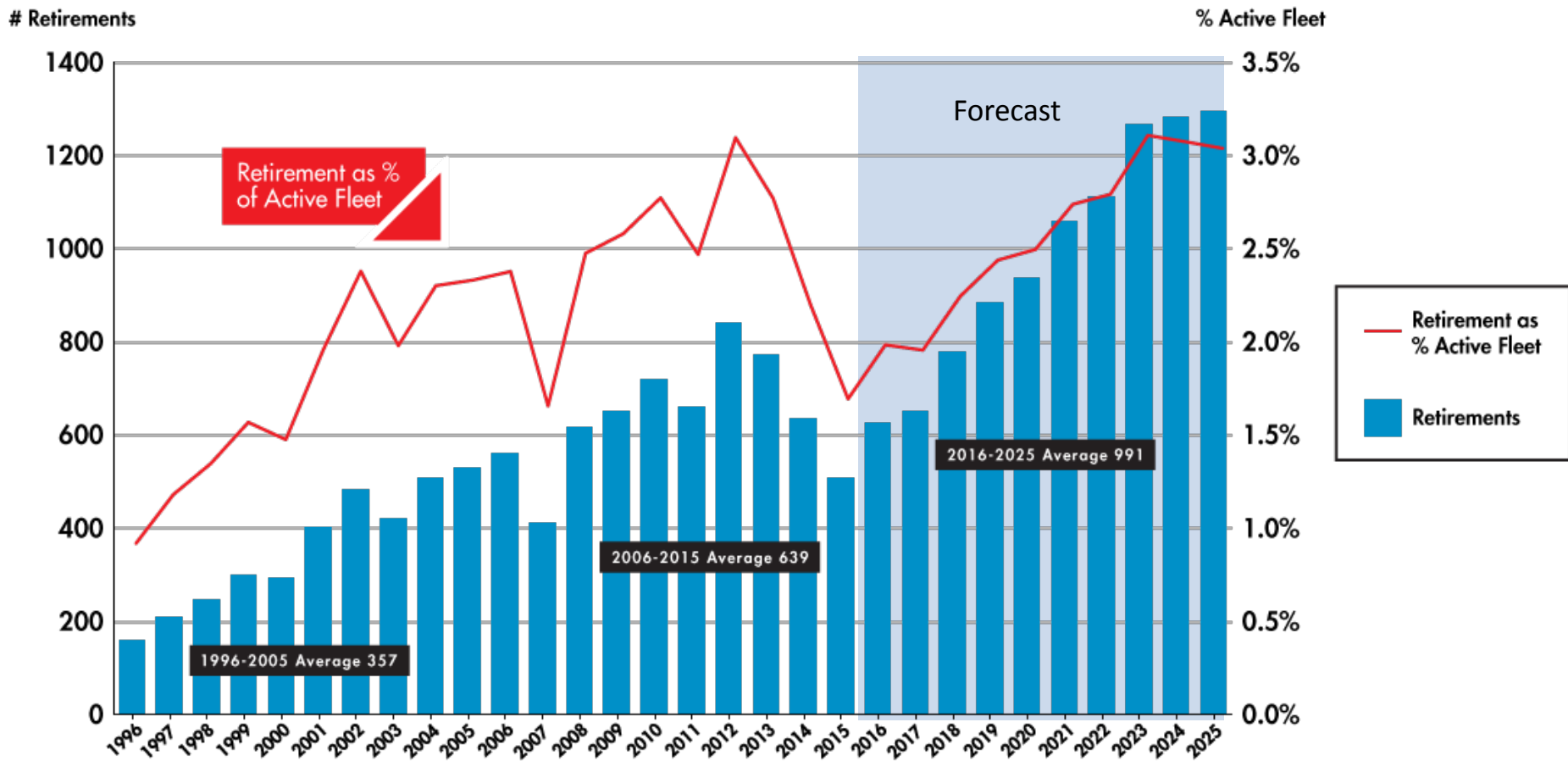

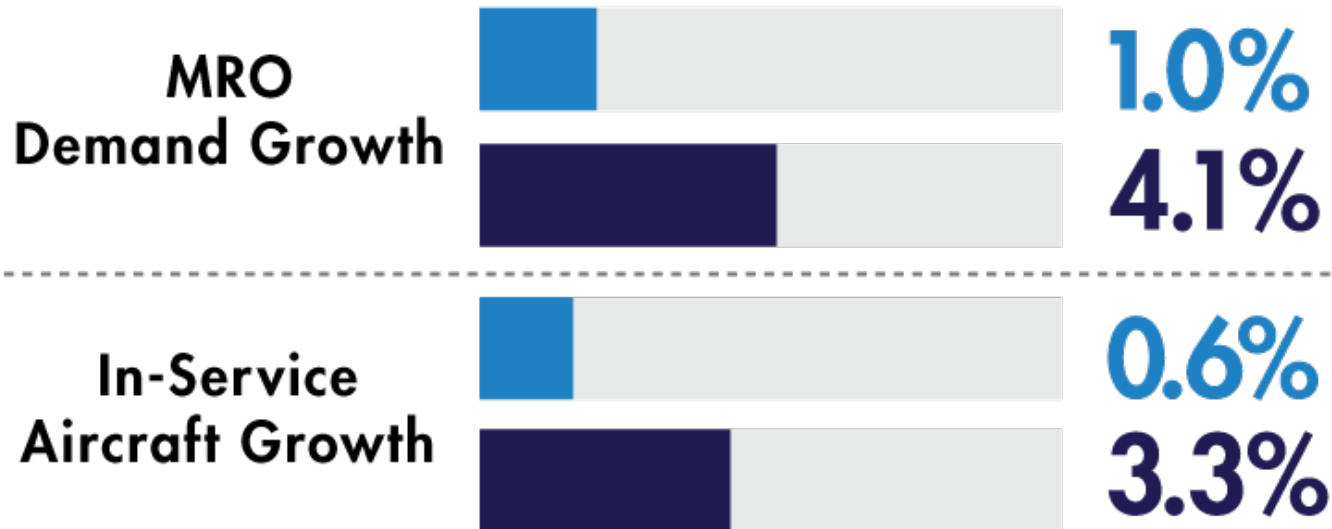

2016-2025

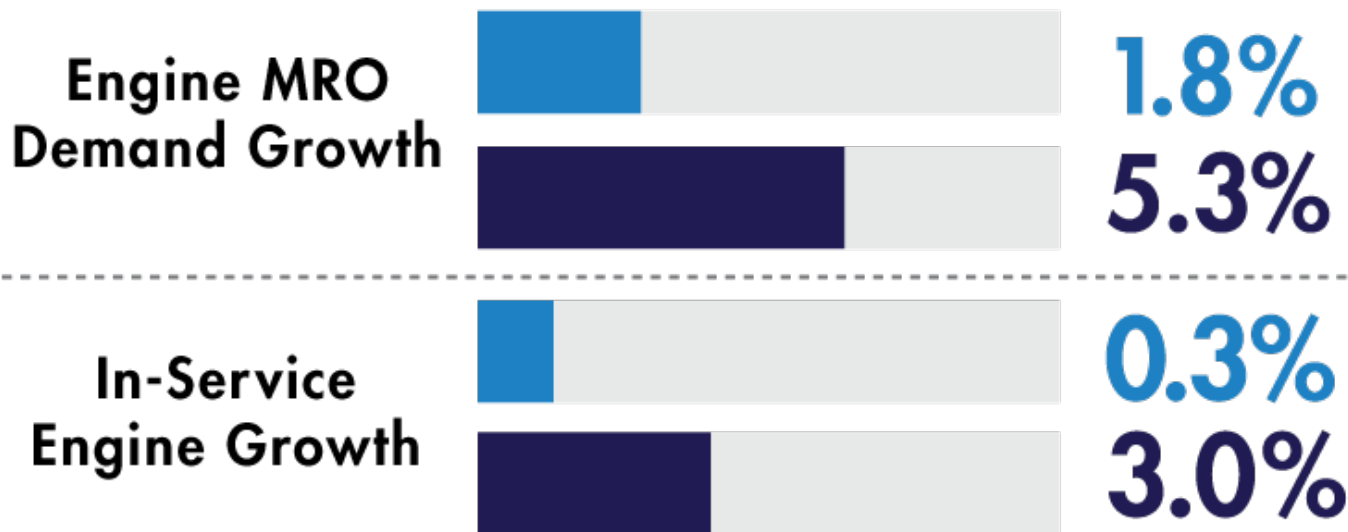
